AWARDS

Scholarships will be awarded up to \$1500. The available scholarships may be used for tuition, books, room and board and/or other related expenses.

ELIGIBILITY

- ◆ The scholarships are available to college students whose parents, legal guardians or who themselves are a member in good standing of Southwestern Illinois Laborers' District Council.
- ◆ Applicants must be enrolled Full Time in a University, College or Vocational School and provide proof of enrollment.
- ◆ High School graduating applicants must provide transcripts for the past 4 years. College students must maintain at least a 2.6 cumulative grade point average for the 2018-2019 school year and provide transcripts for the previous year.

*Recipients of the scholarship must be present at the District Council meeting to receive the award. Recipients must also volunteer at least 1 day each year and or participate in fundraising efforts or other Union business required by the Business Manager.
